Nomination of Thomas P. Clifford for Vice Chairman was made by Randolph Carroll, with a **Second** by Loisann Marazzi. **MOTION PASSED**, 2 yes, 0 no, Mr. Clifford abstained.

Nomination of Loisann Marazzi for Secretary was made by Thomas P. Clifford, with a **Second** by Randolph Carroll. **MOTION PASSED**, 2 yes, 0 no, Loisann Marazzi abstained.

A **MOTION** to adopt The Amended Roberts Rules of Order was made by Thomas P. Clifford, with a **Second** by Loisann Marazzi. **MOTION PASSED**, 3 yes, 0 no.

A **MOTION** to reappoint Maureen C. Levine Recording Secretary was made by Randolph Carroll, with a **Second** by Loisann Marazzi to move the motion. **MOTION PASSED**, 2 yes, 0 no, Mr. Clifford abstained.

Eileen Krugel arrived at 7:15p.m.

Mayor Casseti addressed the board stating that the city will be celebrating their 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary and I just want to know what this board can put into this special event. I have the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary book when Mayor Clifford was Mayor and it is a wonderful program and I want to know if we can do the same thing for the 125<sup>th</sup> one. The board suggesting putting a group of people together to work on the project, involving the Cultural Commission, The Friends of the Library, Valley Arts Council, etc.. Eileen Krugel suggested, reprint the 100<sup>th</sup> year and go forward to the 125<sup>th</sup>. The group thought

that the fall would be a good time to celebrate this and work it into the Harvest Festival, a discussion followed.
