Randolph Carroll stated that he talked to Peter Kelly, Economic Director, and he said that the state has already declared Upper Main Street as a Historic District but that the city never did. He will be meeting with Mr. Kelly on Monday to see what information he has on the subject and then go to the Ordinance Committee and ask

them to make an ordinance to create a Historic District on Upper Main Street. Bart Flaherty suggested that Mr. Carroll find out what type of designation we want and how stringent that designation would be and a discussion followed.

**D. ANSONIA LIBRARY FOUNTAIN:**

Mr. Carroll stated that he talked to the new Superintendent of Public Works, Doug Novak, and he is going to fix the fountain in the spring.

**E. 8 X 10 PORTRAITS:**

Mr. Carroll stated that there is a poster of all the past Mayors of the City of Ansonia and that Mayor Cassetti would like each picture blown up to 8 X10, so that they could be framed and be put on display in the vestibule of Ansonia City Hall. Mr. Carroll said that Nancy Valentine knows someone that could enlarge the pictures, so he gave her the poster.

**NEW BUSINESS:**


**A. 125<sup>th</sup> CELEBRATION OF THE CITY OF ANSONIA:**
