The Regular Meeting of the Ansonia Energy Improvement District Board was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman Tyszka.

There was a quorum present.

Energy Update

Gary Hale reported that Michael Scorrano has completed the City Wide Energy Audit. He will have a printed copy to the City by April 30th. Mr. Hale said he has been in contact with Jack Betkowski, DPUC Commissioner. Mr. Betkowski suggested the City take the recommendations from the audit on energy efficiency and review what is fundable. The plan is ready to go. The City buildings are pretty good, the Schools are in good shape and the Police Department is in poor shape. The Police Dept. building is a very old building.

Chairman Tyszka asked if they were specific.

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Mr. Hale said the lighting is in good shape. The Ansonia High School solar project should be completed in the month of April. The town's people will not see the solar panels because of the way the roof was built.

Mr. Hale said he will be in contact with the Administration and Board of Aldermen regarding the PWD Complex (trash) and Plan B which involves the sewage treatment being used as bio-gas to create Class I renewable energy. He said if this all comes together within one year the government and schools in Ansonia will be 100% powered by green energy. This would make Ansonia the only city in the State of Connecticut that is all green.

Chairman Tyszka said there has been no money out of Ansonia's pocket to date. This project has not cost the taxpayers any money.

Mr. Hale said that is correct. There has been no cost to the City of Ansonia thus far.
