Call to Order:

Chairman Nicolari states that the Cultural Commission made a profit of \$4600.00 from vendors, \$3150.00 from sponsors, and \$330.00 from the raffle. The total expenses were \$1825.00 for entertainment and \$4800.00 for mums, hay barrels, and pumpkins. The \$330.00 made from the raffle tickets was donated to the Salvation Army.

Mrs. Collicelli hands out a 2014 Tree Lighting Report. Mrs. Collicelli says there was a great turn out of people and the tree looked great. Mrs. Collicelli did however go over some

changes she hopes for next year. Mrs. Collicelli states that the cost for the event was \$167.91 not including the cost of the "elf" costume. Chairman Nicolari adds that Chris Sansone did a phenomenal job playing the Santa role. Chairman Nicolari states that many people commented on how wonderful and patient he was with the children.

Ms. Vitarius Waugh says that the winner of the house decorating contest of 2 years ago was the photo submitted to the Valley Independent Sentinel. Ms. Vitarius Waugh suggests using the prior year winner be the photo submitted. Ms. Vitarius Waugh also adds that her address was wrong on the facebook page as well as the certificate received.


