Mr. Plavnicky explains the meeting was called to approve bids for the roof replacement projects at the following locations:

- Ansonia City Hall
- Eagle Hose
- Nolan Field Field house

At this time members of the board review the bids.

Bids received for the Ansonia City Hall roof replacement project are as follows:

1. Scholar Painting placed a bid of \$28,830.00
2. Silktown Roofing placed a bid of \$38,900.00
3. C & M Roofing placed a bid of \$56,000.00

Bids received for the Eagle Hose roof project are as follows:

1. DiGiorgi Roofing placed a bid of \$47,000.00
2. Silktown Roofing placed a bid of \$51,000.00
3. The Roofing Store LLC placed a bid of \$49,000.00
4. C & M Roofing placed a bid of \$49,000.00
5. Scholar Painting placed a bid of \$58,320.00

Bids received for the Nolan Field field house roof project are as follows:

1. DiGiorgi Roofing placed a bid of \$20,000.00
2. The Roofing Store LLC placed a bid with no amount
3. Scholar Painting placed a bid of \$17, 830.00

Mr. Kolakowski made a motion to approved the lowest bid on all 3 projects. Mr. Plavnicky seconded the motion. All in favor, so carried.

With that being said, the Ansonia City Hall roof replacement project will be awarded to Scholar Painting with a bid of \$28,830.00. The Eagle Hose roof project will be awarded to DiGiorgi Roofing with a bid of \$47,000.00, and the Nolan Field field house roof project will be awarded to Scholar Painting with a bid of \$17,830.00.
