**Call to Order:**

Mr. Plavnicky called the meeting to order, all rose and Pledged Allegiance to the Flag. The recording clerk took a roll call attendance, and a quorum was declared present. (3) P (1)A

**Consideration of Previous Minutes:**

Mr. Plavnicky asked for a consideration of the April 01, 2014 regular monthly meeting minutes.

Mr. Novak noted a mistake. Corrections to be made as follows:

- Under Superintendents Report it should read \$1700.00 is needed for the irrigation pump at Nolan field not \$17000.00

Mr. Kolakowski made a motion to accept the previous minutes with necessary corrections. Mr. Geruntho seconded the motion. All in favor, so carried.

**Public Session:**

Mr. Plavnicky called the Public Session to order. No one from the public was present. Mr. Plavnicky declared the Public Session closed at 6:02 p.m.

**Superintendents Report:**

A detailed copy of the Superintendents Report, Transfer Station Report, and the Attendance Report are attached for your review.

Mr. Novak hands out pictures of a wall at a Public Works garage that needs repair. Mr. Novak says repairs will start soon. Mr. Kolakowski asks the cost of repairs. Mr. Novak says it will all be done in house.

Mr. Novak goes over the vehicle report and says that Public Works is in need of 2 new 9 ton dump trucks. Mr. Novak says he approached BOAT regarding the expenses over the next 5 years. The cost of the vehicles has been approved.

Mr. Stowe asks if a mason truck has been approved for purchase. Mr. Novak says at this time only the two 9 ton dump trucks have been approved.

Mr. Novak asks the board for approval to purchase a 2011 Ford pick up truck. Mr. Kolakowski makes a motion to approve. Mr. Geruntho seconded the motion. All in favor, so carried.

Mr. Kolakowski asks about road repairs. Mr. Novak says there is a plan for these repairs.

Mr. Kolakowski makes a motion to accept the Superintendents Report. Mr. Plavnicky seconded the motion. All in favor, so carried.

### **New Business:**

Mr. Kolakowski asks about 7 new hires. Mr. Novak says that they have hired 7 part time, seasonal employees. Mr. Novak says that there were over 30 applicants and after reviewing and interviewing they have hired 7. Mr. Kolakowski asks why the board was not notified prior to these hirings. Mr. Novak says because these are part time seasonal employees working no more than 19.75 hours per week. Mr. Novak says he did meet the Affirmative Action laws within these new hires. Mr. Novak says so far there have been no issues with any of the new hires.

### **Bids:**

A bid of \$20,000 was placed by Complete to repair an embankment at 191 Prospect Street. Mr. Kolakowski makes a motion to allow the project to be done as long as the money is allotted. Mr. Geruntho seconded the motion. All in favor, so carried.

### **Consideration of Bills:**

Mr. Kolakowski made a motion to accept bills. Mr. Geruntho seconded the motion. All in favor, so carried.

### **Executive Session:**

Executive Session did not take place.
