Call to Order:

Chairman Finnucan called the Board of Public Works meeting to order at 6:02 P.M. All rose, Pledged Allegiance to the Flag. The recording clerk took a roll call attendance and a quorum was declared present. (3) P (1)A

Consideration of Previous Minutes:

Mr. Geruntho made a motion to accept the minutes from the meeting dated March 03, 2015. Mr. Plavnicky seconded the motion. All in favor, so carried.

Public Session:

No one from the public present.

Superintendents Report:

Mr. Novak says he has completed the interviews for the seasonal temporary employees. Mr. Novak states there is enough money to hire 6 seasonal employees. The hires are: Mike Morey, Matthew Simon, John Coppola, Kente Douglas, and Kenneth Belardini. These employees will work 19.5 hours per week.

Mr. Novak says wireless internet has been installed in the Public Works division of the complex.

Mr. Novak says Carmen Pitney is still out and will hopefully return the first of June.

Mr. Novak tells the board that 11 crew members are currently attending an OSHA 30 training. 2 employees will be attending a transition to supervisor training.

Mr. Novak states the windows at the field house have been installed.

Mr. Novak says he is looking into purchasing a mower for Nolan Field. Mr. Novak says it took only 15 minutes to mow Nolan Field where now it is taking upwards to 2 hours or more. Mr. Finnucan asks how much the mower will cost. Mr. Novak states \$25,000.

Mr. Plavnicky asks if vendors need to be up to date with taxes prior to doing work for the city. Mr. Novak says that was his understanding that if taxes are owed to the city from a contractor, the bid will be turned down. Mr. Novak says that he has not seen this in writing and that Attorney John Marini is currently looking into this further.

Mr. Geruntho makes a motion to accept the Superintendents Report. Mr. Plavnicky seconded the motion. All in favor, so carried.

New Business:

Mr. Novak says he received three bids for the sewer project at City Hall. The bids are as follows:

- Frank Pepe Construction \$22,300.00
- Complete Construction \$15,960.00
- Ed McManus and Sons \$13,975.00

Chairman Finnucan makes a recommendation to go with Ed McManus and Sons with a bid of \$13,975.00. Mr. Geruntho makes a motion to accept. Mr. Plavnicky seconded the motion. All in favor, so carried.

Mr. Donald Smith Jr. an engineer from Seymour hands out a packet in regards to the boiler replacement project at Ansonia Public Library. Mr. Smith goes over the packet and what it includes.

Mr. Geruntho makes a motion to send this project out to bid. Mr. Plavnicky seconded the motion. All in favor, so carried.

Mr. Plavnicky asks how someone goes about getting use of the Soccer fields. Mr. Finnucan says that would have to go through the Board of Recreation. Mr. Novak says that at this time the fields are all scheduled and being used by our in town youth and high school teams.

Consideration of Bills:

Mr. Plavnicky made a motion to accept the bills. Mr. Geruntho seconded the motion. All in favor, so carried.
