Call to Order:

Due to having no quorum, a discussion was held. Mr. Plavnicky introduced Mr. Kenny Belardinelli who will be a new member to the board after being sworn in at the next Board of Alderman meeting.

Mr. Novak gave some updates in regards to projects that are already underway.

Mr. Novak says the new street sweeper should be purchased sometime between now and mid August.

Mr. Novak says that 12 Public Works employees attended CPR training last month, and that the remainder will go in the fall.

Mr. Novak says West Mechanical is working on the boiler project at the Library and it should be complete within 90 days.

Mr. Novak states the new 108' mower that was purchased for Nolan Field Complex will arrive Thursday.

Mr. Novak says the Webster Hose floor is going to be a major project that insurance will not pay for. Mr. Plavnicky asks is it necessary for the job to be done. Mr. Novak says it is unsafe and must be done.

Mr. Novak tells the board that he proposed to the Board of Recreation that the area at Colony Park formally tennis courts be turned into volleyball courts and a dog park for residence use.

Mr. Novak says that all the hired summer help are doing great. Mr. Novak continues to say that Scale Operator Tim Holman asked for a summer employee check license and registration at the Transfer Station to make sure it is being used by Ansonia Residents.

Mr. Novak says that they are negotiating the Union Contracts. He says the next meeting will be July 22, 2015.
