Special Meeting – November 9, 2010

Call to Order

The Special Meeting of the Ansonia Board of Aldermen was called to order at 6:45 p.m. by Aldermanic President Stephen Blume. All those present rose and pledged allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Town and City Clerk Madeline Bottone read aloud the call of the meeting.

Alderman Sharkey MOVED to accept the call of the meeting; SECONDED by Alderman Jeanette. A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 9-0.

Purpose:

1. To act upon the resignation of James Fainer, Second Ward Alderman.

Alderman Jeanette MOVED to accept, with regret, the resignation of James Fainer as Second Ward Alderman and to send him a letter of thanks for his service to the City; SECONDED by Alderman Nihill. A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 9-0.

2. To fill vacancy, the Board of Aldermen will vote to elect a registered voter as an Alderman in the Second Ward of the City of Ansonia in accordance with Section 143 of the City Charter.

Alderman Sharkey MOVED to appoint Peter J. Danielczuk of 15 North Street as an Alderman in the Second Ward; SECONDED by Alderman Knapp.

President Blume asked three times if there were any further nominations.

Being none, the nominations were closed on a motion by Alderman Sharkey, seconded by Alderman Knapp and unanimous.

A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 9-0 to elect Peter J. Danielczuk as an Alderman in the Second Ward of the City of Ansonia.

Adjournment

Alderman Knapp MOVED to adjourn; SECONDED by Alderman Nihill. A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 9-0.
