Corporation Counsel Blake stated, there are two things here. One is for the Police Assistance Agreement between the City of Ansonia and the Town of Seymour regarding private duty assignments and pay. We are doing this pursuant to Statute Section 7148cc and the other thing is regarding the Ansonia Rescue and Medical Services, regarding a change in some of the wording regarding what the director is and the term. I just want to let you know for the record that this was published on February 1, 2011 and February 3, 2011 and this will go to the Board of Aldermen to vote on. It still has to be published three more times in the daily newspaper, which is The New Haven Register.

**3. *Discussion and comment regarding Ansonia City Code Section 2-169(a) and the Police Assistance Agreement between the City of Ansonia and the Town of Seymour (take appropriate action)***

Alderman Sharkey MOVED to dispense with the reading of the entire Police Assistance Agreement; SECONDED by Alderman Fainer. A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 6-0.

Alderman Sharkey MOVED to recommend to the full Board of Aldermen the approval of the Police Assistance Agreement between the City of Ansonia and the Town of Seymour; SECONDED by Alderman Knapp. A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 5 Yes, 0 No, 1 Abstention (Nihill).

Alderman Fainer moved to recommend to the full Board of Aldermen the approval of the revisions of Ansonia City Code Section 2-169(a); SECONDED by Alderman Sharkey. A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 6-0.
