Call to Order

The Special Meeting of the Ansonia Board of Aldermen was called to order at 6:45 p.m. by Aldermanic President Stephen Blume. All those present rose and pledged allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

1. Call of the Meeting

Town and City Clerk Madeline Bottone read aloud the call of the meeting.

Alderman Sharkey MOVED to accept the call of the meeting; SECONDED by Alderman Nihill. A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 9-0.

2. To fill a vacancy, the Board of Aldermen will vote to elect a registered voter as an Alderman in the Fifth Ward of the City of Ansonia in accordance with Section 143 of the City Charter.

Alderman Sharkey NOMINATED Jay Fainer of 76 Great Hill Road as an Alderman in the Fifth Ward; SECONDED by Alderman Knapp.

Alderman Sharkey stated, Jay has been a lifelong Ansonia resident, he is member of Charter Hose Company and a member of ARMS. He has volunteered his services for years to the City and I know he will make a fine addition to the Board of Aldermen.

President Blume asked three times if there were any further nominations. Being none, the nominations were closed on a motion by Alderman Sharkey, seconded by Alderman Knapp and unanimous.

A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 9-0 to elect Jay Fainer as an Alderman in the Fifth Ward of the City of Ansonia.

President Blume congratulated Mr. Fainer as applause rang throughout the forum.

Alderman Jay Fainer was immediately sworn in by Mayor James Della Volpe.

Adjournment

Alderman Sharkey MOVED to adjourn; SECONDED by Alderman Nihill. A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 9-0.
