### *Call to Order*

**Alderman Adamowski MOVED to appoint Christopher Phipps to the Ansonia Board of Education to fill the unexpired term of Edward Sharkey, Jr.; SECONDED by Alderman Jeanette.**

President Sharkey stated, Christopher Phipps is a lifelong Ansonia resident, a product of the Ansonia School System. He has children in Ansonia schools and he has stepped forward to fill the unexpired term of Mr. Sharkey.

**A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 11-0.**
