Public Session: Comptroller Bill Nimons spoke and suggested that the city set up A Worker's Compensation reserve fund. He further suggested that the city create an account for postemployment benefits for employee sick and vacation accruals.

A motion was made by Phil Tripp, with all Joe Jeanette to forward to the full board of alderman an ordinance restricting sexually oriented businesses in Ansonia. Motion seconded by Lorie Vaccaro, and past 4 to 0.

Motion made by Phil Tripp to change the cities parking fines, seconded by Pat Henri, passed 4 to 0.

Motion made by Lorie Vaccaro to pass on to the full board of alderman the scrap policy ordinance, seconded by Phil Tripp, passed 4 to 0.

Motion made by Lorie Vaccaro to pass on to the full board of alderman the scrap policy ordinance, seconded by Phil Tripp, past 4 to 0.

Motion to revise the fee structure for administrative appeals from the zoning enforcement officer was made by Phil Tripp, seconded by Pat Henri, passed 4 to 0.

A motion was made by Pat Henri, seconded by Phil Tripp to pass on to the full board of alderman ordinance regarding the revision of section 25A- 2 four delinquent taxes, permits bonds, regarding procedures for contractors, passed 4 to 0.

Regulations regarding the switches solicitation for veterans causes, was passed, pending further discussion.
