2. Fill the Vacancy of Alderman of the Seventh Ward

Alderman Blackwell MOVED to appoint Frank DeLibero as Alderman in the 7th Ward; SECONDED by Alderman Edo.

Alderman Blackwell explained that Mr. DeLibero has been a City resident for 15 years; has two children that went through the Ansonia school system. He has been active as a coach and has served on both the Recreation Commission and the Board of Apportionment and Taxation. He stated his belief that Mr. DeLibero will be a great asset to the City and looks forward to working with him in the 7th Ward to try and accomplish the goals of the Mayor and this administration city-wide.

A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 12 Yes, 1 No (Radin).

Alderman DeLibero was immediately sworn in by Mayor Cassetti and joined the Board at the table. Applause rang throughout the forum.

Alderman Cassetti MOVED to adjourn; SECONDED by Alderman Jeanette. A voice vote was taken and the MOTION PASSED 14-0.
