Call to Order:

Attorney Jaumann called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. All rose, Pledged Allegiance to the Flag. Attorney Jaumann called upon Mr. Charles Collinge property owner of 92 Beaver Street Ansonia, CT 06401. Attorney Jaumann briefly explains the appeal process.

Mr. Blackwell asks if Mr. Collinge can purchase a car cover, not a tarp but a fitted car cover. Mr. Collinge states that he will indeed do that.

Mr. Collinge has updated photos and says that some of the debris clean up has been done. Mr. Collinge explains his situation and says that his children are out of state so there is really nobody around to help him. Mr. Collinge adds that he does have a friend who is willing to loan him the stuff to fix paint but not until the month of May,

Attorney Jaumann says another hearing will be scheduled and Mr. Blackwell will be by in two weeks to see that the debris is cleaned up and the car is covered properly. Attorney Jaumann sets a date of June 14, 2016 to hold another hearing in regards to the paint and if it has been remediated.
