Mr. Madar made a motion to accept the call of the meeting. Mr. Bettini seconded. All in favor, so carried.

Chairman Holman asked if there was anyone from the public that wished to address the Commission on the revised Inland Wetlands & Watercourse Regulations for the City of Ansonia.

He asked three (3) times. There was no one present from the public who wished to address the commission.

Mr. Bettini stated the revised regulations are an excellent addition to the practices and policies and the fact that our Commission is considering adopting the State Regulations will serve Ansonia in the future and they will stay current with updates to the Regulations from the State of Connecticut.

Chairman Holman said other Connecticut towns have adopted these State Regulations and Ansonia is in line with the Regulations and the fees. We fall into the State guidelines. He is happy to present these new regulations to the residents of Ansonia. It was a long time in revising them.

Chairman Holman said we are changing the rules and regulations because the past regulations didn't protect us. The State Regulations and fee schedule is in line with the other cities in Connecticut. He asked if all of the commissioners have had a chance to review the new Regulations.

Chairman Holman asked if there was anyone present from the public who would like to speak on the revised Inland Wetland Regulations. He asked three (3) times and there was no one that wished to speak.

Mr. Bettini asked that the new Regulations with the fees are posted on the web site. He said that the IWC has to make certain that the process is in place to update the Regulations on line.


Chairman Holman said that he will make sure the IWC Regulations are kept updated on line.
