The regular meeting of the Ansonia Conservation Commission was called to order at 5:05 p.m. by Chairman Urban.

There was no quorum present.

Chairman Urban presented a bill for the CCA Annual membership in the amount of \$100.

There was discussion on the Falcon Hall request to expand the parking lot. Chairman Urban was concerned with the report presented by their Soil Scientist – Ray Shook.

The secretary stated that Mr. Horbal disclosed that there is a watercourse (Beaver Brook) within the 100 foot buffer adjoining the property and the Army Corp of Engineers Flood Wall.

Chairman Urban discussed the State of Conn. letter regarding notification of permit for the Naugatuck River. He said that this permit should be approved by local Inland Wetlands Commissions as well as the State DEP.

Chairman Urban said that he wanted to discuss an article on pesticides and health dangers with the commission members. He will bring the newspaper article to the next meeting. He said he was astounded by the Medical findings in the article.

Chairman Urban discussed the property where Falcon Hall is located and the property where they want to expand the parking lot. He said he was happy that the commission members went out to the site last month for a site inspection.

Chairman Urban noted that to the best of his knowledge the Housatonic River Basin Commission has not received any contribution from the City of Ansonia. He said that the City of Ansonia has been asked and to date nothing has been received.

Chairman Urban declared the meeting adjourned at 5:30 p.m.
