## **Bills**

Chairman Urban presented the following bills:

1. Connecticut Conservation Association: Annual Dues \$100

2. Connecticut Bar Association: Land Use Book \$45

Chairman Urban stated the CT Bar Association held a land use seminar not too long ago and the commission was invited to attend. They offered commissions the opportunity to purchase a Land Use Book for \$45. He suggested the Commission purchase a copy.

Mr. Pergola made a motion to purchase a copy of the Land Use Book from the CT Bar Association for \$45. Mr. Joe Cassetti seconded. All in favor, so carried.

3. Seymour Land Trust: Membership for those present: \$100

Mr. Carroll made a motion to approve the membership payment. Mr. Pergola seconded. All in favor, so carried.

There was no correspondence received.

Mr. Pergola said that he spoke with Supt. Novak and he said that PWD will pull the tables out of Fountain Lake. There is more than one table in the lake and dam area.

Mr. Carroll said that Supt. Novak lifted the trees in Gatison Park. It was good for the trees and the Park. It enables the Police to clearly view the park and area. He said he asked the Mayor to

Mr. Joe Cassetti made a motion to table the referendum issue until the September meeting. Mr. Pergola seconded. All in favor, so carried.


### **July & August Meetings**
