Pursuant to C.G.S. Section 7-255, a public hearing with respect to Sewer Use Capital Fee Charges will be held on Wednesday, April 6, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at Ansonia City Hall, Erlingheuser Room, 253 Main Street for the purpose to receive input from the citizens of the City of Ansonia on the proposed Sewer Use Capital Fee for the Facility Plant Improvements as required by State and Federal mandates. The users may consist of, but are not limited to, residential, non-residential, non-conforming mixed use commercial, private, commercial and non-commercial, industrial and non-industrial, charitable and religious and municipal and educational institutions served by the Ansonia Sewer System and within the billing system connected, or to be connected, into the Ansonia sewer system.

The fair and effective proposed charge is currently a \$270 sewer surcharge per occupancy/dwelling unit with multipliers for the categories of land use.

A copy of said full proposed Sewer Use Capital Fee for Facility Plant is on file in the office of the Town and City Clerk at Ansonia City Hall, 253 Main St. and is available for inspection by the public.
