U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), Homeland Security Investigations (HSI), is committed to protecting the public and ensuring that the rights of victims are observed. HSI administers a Victim Notification Program which allows eligible victims and witnesses to obtain reliable and timely information regarding a criminal alien's release from custody. However, victims and witnesses are required to register with our agency in order to receive notification of a criminal alien's release.

To this end, HSI is respectfully requesting your department's assistance with informing victims and witnesses located within your geographic area about this valuable program. We are hoping that your department can place a hyperlink to the HSI's Victim Notification Program on your department's website.
